Genesis 17:19

God said, "No, but your wife Sarah shall bear you a son, and you shall name him Isaac. I will establish my covenant with him as an everlasting covenant for his offspring after him.

Genesis 21:1-3

<u>1</u>Then the LORD took note of Sarah as He had said, and the LORD did for Sarah as He had [a]promised. <u>2</u> So Sarah conceived and bore a son to Abraham in his old age, at the appointed time of which God had spoken to him. <u>3</u> Abraham named his son who was born to him, the son whom Sarah bore to him, Isaac.

I Kings 22:38
